## Exploration & Discovery

### INTRODUCTION

Explore the properties of water using a variety of different objects.

### WHAT WE NEED

- A sponge or scrunchie
- An empty water bottle
- Plastic cups, empty yogurt pots, straws
- A face cloth

### WHAT TO DO

Pierce some holes in the bottom of the bottle to make a watering can. Plastic cups and yogurt pots can be used for pouring, and they make great boats!

Sponges and scrunchies allow your child to explore different textures, and can be used for filling up the cups.

Have a race with the yogurt pot boats using a straw to blow them along, and for younger babies and toddlers play peekaboo with a face cloth.
