

INVISIBLE & ICE PAINTING

Experimenting with Art

INTRODUCTION

Two exciting way to change up painting and turn it into a fun experiment

WHAT WE NEED

- Wax candle or white crayon
- Paper
- Tempera paint
- Ice cube tray or junk containers, lolly pop sticks

WHAT TO DO

Invisible Painting: use a wax candle or white crayon to draw an invisible picture. Paint over the picture with thin paint to reveal the image. A darker colour of paint will give a better result.

Ice Painting: freeze a mix of water and tempera paint in an ice cube tray or junk containers, adding lolly pop sticks for handles. Allow to melt slightly before using it to paint. You can refreeze afterward to use it again and again!
