INTRODUCTION

A shape sorter allows young children to strengthen their hand-eye coordination, fine motor and problem solving skills, as well as develop their vocabulary knowledge (e.g. being able to identify and name shapes)

WHAT WE NEED

- Cardboard box
- Shapes (lego/wooden blocks/other small objects you can find lying around)
- Scissors and a pen

WHAT TO DO

Place the shapes on top of the box and draw around them.

Cut out the shapes to make holes.

Encourage the children to put all the shapes into the box using the holes.
